The MA program in Quantitative Methodology requires at least 30¹ credit hours of course work. The program is designed to give students a strong theoretical grounding and research experience in quantitative research methodologies and techniques. Students must write and defend a thesis as part of this program. Graduates of this program usually continue on to a doctoral degree. Only graduate level courses (course numbers 6000 and above) may be used toward the earning of a graduate degree. Online courses will have an "E" after the number on the schedule (ex. EPSY 7110E). ⁱ The University of Georgia Graduate School requires a minimum of 30 graduate credit hours for an MA program. Of those 30 credit hours, 21 credit hours must be from coursework, with the remainder being 7000 research or 7300 thesis-writing or other related graduate credit hours. Of the 21 credit hours of coursework, 12 hours must be in courses that are only open to graduate students.

ⁱⁱ Equivalent courses may be used to replace required courses with the consent of the student's advisory committee. The total number of hours for the degree program does not change.

ⁱⁱⁱ Elective course numbers must be 6000 and above.
